## **Rules and Regulations Governing the Hampden Township Republican Association Scholarship**

1. An applicant must be a resident of Hampden Township, Cumberland County.
2. An applicant must be a high school senior at a public, charter, parochial, or private high school or home school.
3. The applicant and/or at least one of the applicant's parents or guardians must be a registered Republican voter.
4. The Scholarship shall be available for an undergraduate program, shall be granted for only one (1) year, and is not renewable.
5. Finalists for the Scholarship shall be selected based on scholastic achievement and extracurricular activities in and out of school. Financial need will not be considered.
6. The applicant must produce evidence of scholarly achievement by school transcript, recent report card, and a letter of acceptance to an accredited institution of higher education.
7. The Scholarship Chairperson must receive all applications for the Scholarship by the date indicated on the application package.
8. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and notify applicants who are identified as finalists.
9. Finalists will be invited to attend the Hampden Township Republican Association's Scholarship Night on Monday, April 5, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. to present their credentials to the membership present, who will select the scholarship recipient by secret ballot.
10. The selected recipient will be awarded the Scholarship at his or her school's Awards Program.
11. The Scholarship shall be made payable to the chosen recipient.
